ENAF Audio-visual Podcasts Launch | CHAGUA MAMA: Ni Tyme ya Mama!



Jubilation galore after signing of the MOU between ENAF, Uraia Trust and Kenya Broadcasting Corporation - Channel 1

On Tuesday 30th July 2024, Echo Network Africa Foundation (ENAF) and the Democracy trust Fund (DTF), in collaboration with Uraia Trust and the Kenya Broadcasting Corporation (KBC), launched and signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU). This marked the commencement of the production and transmission of a series of 'Chagua Mama - Ni Tyme ya Mama' short documentaries/audio-visual podcasts which shall be produced and aired between July and December 2024.

These podcasts aim to spotlight leaders who are women, particularly female Members of County Assemblies (MCAs) from various counties in Kenya. They will highlight their journeys in politics, the successes they have achieved, the challenges they have encountered and their various agenda for the electorate.

A key objective of these podcasts is a societal change in the perspective and attitudes regarding electoral choices, highly encouraging the election of women leaders and in particular - MCAs who are women.

The event was graced and hosted by Dr. Jennifer Riria - President/CEO of ENAF.

Women Leadership, Political Participation and Governance

2024 Grant Makers Summit

Echo Network Africa Foundation through the Democracy Trust Fund (DTF) convened a consultative meeting to review and develop memoranda on the Political Parties and Election Offenses (Amendment) Bills, 2024.



The session brought together leaders who are women in the political space to provide input on proposed amendments in the two Bills, as part of the public participation process; with emphasis on gender implications.



Key stakeholders present included: representatives from the Office of the Registrar of Political Parties (ORPP) and the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission (IEBC).

Data collection for the Kuza Jamii Project in five (5) counties has drawn to a close. Twelve single Gender Focus Group Discussions were conducted across Mandera, Garissa, tana River, Isiolo and Marsabit Counties.

The study questions were informed by four domains, namely:

- Cultural norms and beliefs
- Gender roles, responsibilities and time use
- Access to and control of resources
- Patterns of power and decision making.

The aim was to establish the status of the abovementioned domains in the target communities and how these influence the success of the Economic Inclusion Programme.
